Welsh Photographic Federation Associate Assessment Day

The 2024 AWPF Assessment took place on 3rd November at the Talbot Green Community Centre, and it was heartening to see so many attendees from across the country supporting this significant event in Welsh photography. I extend my sincere thanks to everyone who came to witness the assessment process and to those who contributed to its success.

I am pleased to report that this year's AWPF assessment had a total of 18 candidates: 16 submitted printed panels and 2 submitted digital panels. It was inspiring to see the quality of work presented, with 11 out of 16 print submissions meeting the rigorous standards required for the award, resulting in a 69% success rate in the print category. While the digital submissions were not successful this year, the overall success rate for the assessment was 61%.



For sale is my Nikon Z5 full frame camera, with a Nikon Z 24-200mm f/4-6.3 VR kit lens, and various accessories.

It is a highly regarded camera, with DPreview website giving it a gold award - the review and all the features and specifications are here: https://www.dpreview.com/reviews/nikon-z5-review

Also note it is the Vibration Reduction (VR) lens.

I bought it in June 2021 from new. I have looked over it carefully and it is in brand new condition - I can't see a single scratch or mark on it. The shutter count is just 2305. If you look across the internet then typical hobby usage of cameras is usually between 10,000 and 20,000 per year. So it has hardly been used.

The firmware has been upgraded to the latest v1.4.3

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It comes with the following accessories:

- x2 SD memory cards the main 128Gb Lexar card and a backup 32Gb card. The camera allows x2 cards to be used at a time in different ways.
- Printed user manual.
- Battery charger btw the battery is being reported by the camera as level 1 grade, which is as new.
- 3x filters a UV filter for protection, a circular polariser, and a neutral density filter rated at ND1000.
- A spare LCD screen protector.
- Smallrig detachable camera strap connectors.
- Various smaller bags and cloths to protect and clean the lens and camera.
- Cables for data connections and a USB SD card reader for your computer.
- Original box and packaging.
- A Nikon black soft camera bag in as new condition.
- A brown/tan Billingham style camera bag that I love, but it is absolutely falling to bits! Just including it as I will
 have no need for it.

Always tricky to know how to price this sort of thing, so I have done some research across eBay and other sites to see what this is all worth.


The camera average looks ~£600, and the lens ~£500. I am therefore putting all the accessories, bags and the delivery together for £100 and hence the asking price of £1,200.
